## Medical Center Locks Doors

Starting July 15, all Medical Center entrances will be closed and locked at night. You will need to scan your Southwest physician ID badge to enter the building during the hours noted below.

- Pharmacy entrance 9 pm to 4:30 am
- Pavilion 9:45 pm to 5 am (Badge access, ground floor, side door)
- All other entrances 10 pm to 4:30 am

Most entries will have a buzzer and intercom to Switchboard, with remotely activated door release, for physicians, patients and visitors.

## Tumor Board Revamped

Tumor Board is changing formats and days to make the meeting more informative and relevant. Starting July 10, Tumor Board will be 7-8 am. Initially, it will be held the second Thursday of each month. Dr. Chris Rubano, (ACoS Liaison Physician) will chair the first session. A hot breakfast is provided. The chair will rotate monthly to include oncologists, surgeons and internists. Though not available July 10, a projection microscope will show live images from glass pathology slides.

## Notification Network Provides MD Alerts

- The Health Care Notification Network is a new, free service to deliver Food and Drug Administration drug and device safety alerts via e-mail.
- These e-mail messages are expected to increase the speed with which doctors receive safety alerts.
- The network should be up in July, but paper alerts will continue to be sent via the U.S. Postal Service.
- The AMA, the FDA, specialty societies, liability carriers and health plans are recommending physicians register for HCNN with their liability carrier or online at [www.hcnn.net](http://www.hcnn.net).

- Enter # plus 1
- Enter 4-digit physician ID number
- Enter 7-digit Medical Record #

The system will search and begin playing the most recent dictation. Use 5 on your keypad to skip reports until you reach the report desired.
